<p>The courses marked with an asterisk MUST be completed by the end of your Sophomore year.</p> <p><b>Michigan Tests of Teacher Certification:</b>  <b>Basic Skills Test</b> – should be taken during the same semester as ED 220 or ED 225  <b>Subject Area Test – Visual Arts Education Test (#95)</b> to be taken the semester prior to OR during the Professional Education Semester.</p> <p><i>Due to the competitive nature of the field, the Art Department encourages students to take more coursework than the minimum requirements.  Students may also complete the requirements and avoid over-load semesters by taking 1 or 2 May Terms.  Art Students should seek advising in both the Education (J. Dell' Olio) and Art Departments.</i></p>
