<p>ÿ 1. Documentation of learnings is organized in a clear and orderly fashion – using one or more of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ÿ notebook ÿ file ÿ journal ÿ other <p>ÿ 2. Each document is labeled with a tab – using the title and/or author’s name</p> <p>ÿ 3. All documentation is included</p> <p>ÿ 4. Includes a <u>table of contents</u> – using the citation format distributed in class for each document</p>			
Narrative:	0 -- 60		
<p>The narrative demonstrates your thinking about your beliefs as you encounter theory, research and new experiences. It clearly guides the reader through the documentation.</p> <p>ÿ 1. Contains <u>original</u> statement of belief. (Start with this)</p> <p>ÿ 2. Contains a statement of your <u>current</u> belief status. (End with this)</p> <p>ÿ 3. Clearly traces your documentation of the professional literature AND how it has challenged/supported/expanded your original belief status.</p> <p>ÿ 4. Specific titles are mentioned throughout.</p> <p>ÿ 5. Text is well written/organized.</p> <p>ÿ 6. Text is technically accurate, word processed, spelling and grammar checked.</p>			
Documentation:	0 – 65		
<p>ÿ 1. Actual documents are included – as opposed to abstracts or summaries produced by the author</p> <p>ÿ 2. Each document is annotated or summarized to show its relationship to the belief statement</p> <p>ÿ 3. Documents are from <u>reliable</u> sources</p> <p>ÿ 4. Shows thorough efforts to find information related to your belief</p>			

<p>ÿ 5. Demonstrates efforts to find/use <u>many</u> sources of information from the professional literature, such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ÿ Databases (one must be from ERIC) ÿ Professional Journals ÿ Periodicals other than journals ÿ Interviews (one is required) ÿ Web sites (professional organizations, etc.) ÿ Others <p>Note: Twenty is the minimum number of sources required. These must be varied, reliable and of substance.</p>
