## **CLARIFICATION OF OPTIONS:**

***Secondary Certification Track with K-12 Endorsement is a major only; no minor is required. Will do student teaching in both secondary and elementary music settings.***

An Instrumental Music Ed major with a K-12 endorsement consists of 79 credits. Candidates for certification in this major must pass the Michigan Test for Teacher Certification (MTTC) in Music Education (Test #39). You must demonstrate your knowledge in the following categories:

1. Music Theory 31-40 items
2. Music Education 31-40 items
3. Music History and Culture 11-20 items

You may access a study guide at the MTTC testing site; the courses below have been selected so that you will be well prepared for the test.

***Note: K-12 Music majors do NOT need to have an academic minor for certification.***
