The Special Education endorsement major in Emotional Impairments for an Elementary teaching certificate consists of a minimum of 49 credits. There is no minor in Emotional Impairments. Most Special Education majors complete a Liberal Arts Substantive minor. Candidates for certification in this major must pass the Michigan Test for Teacher Certification (MTTC) in Emotionally Impaired (Test #59). You must demonstrate your knowledge in the following categories:

1. Human Development/Educ'l Implications of E.I. 11 to 20 items
2. Evaluation, Assessment, and IEPs 11 to 20 items
3. Behavior Management 11 to 20 items
4. Methodology and Instruction 11 to 20 items
5. Program and Service Delivery 11 to 20 items

You may access a study guide at the MTTC testing site; the courses below have been selected so that you will be well prepared for the test.
