OFF-CAMPUS STUDY SOCIAL CONDUCT & BEHAVIOR CONTRACT POLICY

Social maturity was one of the criteria used in approving your application to participate in an off-campus study. Determination of social maturity is made through faculty recommendations and review of your judicial records. Because you were on social probation at the time of your off-campus study application, or had a past of social probation, you are being asked to sign this behavior contract with respect to your participation in your off-campus program.

Should you incur an additional offense or be placed on social probation at any time prior to departure on your program, your approval to participate will be withdrawn. Further, no refund will be made to you of your deposit and you will be billed for any costs incurred by the program that Hope College cannot recover.

While you are participating in an off-campus study program, you remain under the jurisdiction of the Hope College student code of conduct in addition to being responsible to the laws of the country in which you are studying, and to the policies of the program in which you are participating. Should an incident occur while you are studying on a program, Hope College judicial procedures will be invoked.

I have read this document and understand the Hope College social conduct policy for offcampus study, and accept the conditions of this behavior contract. Further, should I fail to uphold my part of this contract, I understand that I will be dismissed from the program and sent back to the College at my expense, including first class airfare if no coach class seat is immediately available.
