

Please complete the following steps prior to your arrival on Hope's campus:

**1 Install Hope College's Symantec free antivirus software.**

- Even if you have antivirus software running, we recommend that you instead run Hope College's Symantec antivirus software because it is updated regularly and is available at no charge to enrolled students.
- Connect to <http://www.hope.edu/cit/>, click on **New Students**, click on **Antivirus Software** & follow the steps.

**2 Check your Hope College e-mail regularly for official class news & campus communication.**

- Visit <http://1.hope.edu>. 1HOPE, Hope's email system, is powered by *Google Apps for Education* (Gmail).

**3 Bring your computer system CDs to campus.**

- In the event that your computer becomes inoperable, your system CDs will be required to rebuild your system. This includes all of the CDs that arrived when your computer was purchased, as well as any that the manufacturer indicated that you should create upon receipt of the system.
