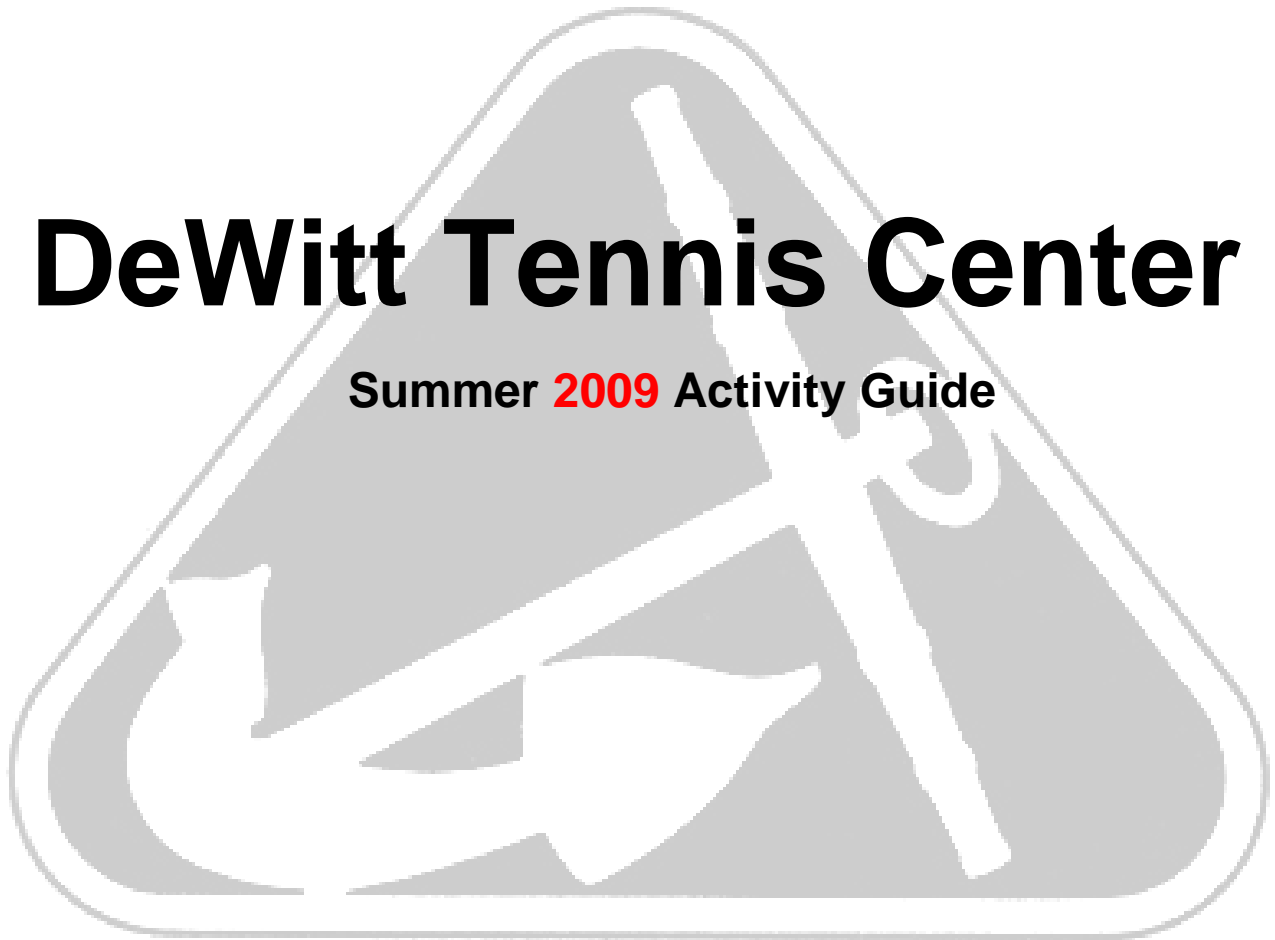


Private Lesson & Private Group Rates

In addition to private lessons, you may choose to form your own private group. This is a great option for players who cannot fit into our regularly scheduled classes. It also offers the ability to choose your own time, the pro, the number and people in the group. The chart below lists all the possible scenarios from which you can pick.

- 1) Private Lessons: members are \$55 per hour; non-members are \$55 per hour.
- 2) In all other cases, non-members, add \$2 per lesson, (not per hour), to the above fees.
- 3) A semi-private lesson with people from the same family is the same price as a private lesson.

Private Lesson Cancellation Policy:

Any cancellations or no shows of private lessons or groups within 24 hours of the scheduled time will be charged at the full rate. Cancellations due to illness must be made within six hours of the private time or the full rate will be charged.

Refund Policy: Any cancellations must be made by 10 a.m. the Wednesday before your week and will have a \$20 cancellation fee applied (\$5 for K-2). Refunds will not be granted after 10 a.m. the Wednesday before your week.

Rescheduling Fee: Players needing to reschedule the week(s) they want will be assessed a \$20 fee (\$5 for K-2).

Makes-Ups: Make-ups are not allowed. Please check your schedule carefully before registering.

Night Academy (Grades 9-12 only)

This class is designed only for players who have to work during the day and cannot attend the daytime Academy. Class meets on Tuesday and Thursday at Holland Christian High School tennis courts. Class will move indoors to the DeWitt Tennis Center in case of inclement weather.

June 9—August 6 9 weeks

Sign up is based on the grade the player will be entering in fall of 2009.

This class runs for nine consecutive weeks – class is not available for individual weeks. However, due to summer travel schedules, players are only charged for seven weeks. Players may attend as many classes as they can fit into their schedules. The DeWitt Tennis Center is our rain back-up.

Players may come all nine weeks if their schedules allow it.

Our unique pricing options allow for maximum flexibility for your child and family. Players can choose from as little as one week or as much as the entire summer or anything in between.

1) Weekly Option: \$225 - Pick any specific week and pay. **(Breaks down to \$9/hour.)**
 Players picking the weekly option must attend one specific week. Breaking up the five days over different weeks is not allowed. Sharing days with other players is not allowed.

2) Summer-Long Option: \$1,300 - Come up to 45 days! **(Breaks down to \$5.78/hour.) Best Value!!**
 Players picking the summer-long option can come every day of the summer (45 days). Players that plan on attending five or more weeks should consider this option.

Refund Policy: Any cancellations must be made by 10 a.m. the Wednesday before your week and will have a \$20 cancellation fee applied (\$5 for K-2). Refunds will not be granted after 10 a.m. the Wednesday before your week.

Rescheduling Fee: Players needing to reschedule the week(s) they want will be assessed a \$20 fee (\$5 for K-2).

Membership Information & Rates

The 2008 – 2009 membership season at the DeWitt Tennis Center (DTC) began Tuesday, September 2, 2008, and continues to Aug 30, 2009. Members may change their membership status any time to include other family members. The cost difference between the two membership fees is due when the change is made.

DTC memberships are non-transferable. The DTC reserves the right to remove the membership of anyone who fails to comply with the policies of the facility. Members are asked to check in at the front desk upon arrival.

For the 15th year in a row, our membership prices have stayed the same with the exception of our junior membership which is now \$150 per year and junior add-on members which are now \$100.

DTC Annual Membership Rates

Tennis Center Rules

Teaching Tennis: The policy of the DTC is that only our own pro staff is allowed to teach lessons at the Tennis Center. The only exception is an adult member wanting to work with his/her own child or spouse. If you are feeding balls to someone other than your spouse or child, we consider that teaching a lesson. This rule applies even if no money is being exchanged.

Smoking: Smoking is prohibited in the DeWitt Tennis Center.

Loss & Damage: The Center is not responsible for injuries, personal damage, lost or stolen items.

Cleanliness: Please help keep the Tennis Center clean by putting coffee cups, pop cans, and other trash in the bins provided. Open containers are not permitted in the court areas.

Comments: Comments and suggestions are always welcomed by the DTC management staff.

Attire: Tennis attire, including a shirt and tennis shoes must be worn on the courts at all times. The following attire is not permitted: street clothes, street shoes, black-soled shoes, cut-offs, and swimwear.

Etiquette: Players should not enter the court area before their court time and must leave when their time has ended. Profanity, racquet throwing, and hitting the curtains or nets is not permitted.

Food and Trash: Food and beverages are not allowed on the courts at any time. All tennis cans and lids, old tennis balls, and other trash should be removed from the courts.

Locker Rooms: Members and their guests may use the temporary lockers without charge. DTC recommends that members bring their own locks since the Tennis Center is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Members must remove their locks when leaving DTC. Locker rooms may only be used in conjunction with tennis playing.

Towels: Towels are available in the locker rooms at no charge. Please put towels in the hamper after use.

Children: All children are the responsibility of the accompanying adult. To minimize the distractions for all players, child spectators are not permitted in the court areas. Children may not be left unsupervised in the lounge areas.

Guests: A Tennis Center member must accompany guests. All guests must register at the front desk when entering the Tennis Center. Guests may use all facilities during their visit, but only in accordance with the Tennis Center rules. No guests may use the Tennis Center more than three times a year.

Guest Fees: Guest fees are charged for all non-members who visit the Tennis Center. The guest fees are \$5 for adults (\$3 for Hope College alumni), and \$3 for juniors (18 years and younger). Members are responsible for insuring that their guests register and pay the appropriate fee. Guest fees may be credited towards the purchase of a Tennis Center membership when appropriate receipts are presented.

Lesson Program Policies

Class Sizes: All classes have enrollment minimums and maximums. Registration is taken on a first come first serve basis for members. The DTC reserves the right to cancel classes due to insufficient enrollment. If classes are cancelled, participants will be notified as soon as possible and full refunds will be issued.

Guests: Guests are welcome to register for any tennis classes, but must wait until the designated non-member sign-up dates to register. Members can register for any class at least one week prior to non-members except in the summer when there is no distinction.

Cancellations & Refunds: All cancellations from a tennis clinic must be made at least 48 hours prior to the start of the class. The DTC will issue refunds ONLY in the case of doctor recommendation or due to moving out of the area. Please check your schedule before registering. Refunds will not be given due to scheduling conflicts. Note: See Academy brochure for cancellation policies specific to the Hope College Summer Tennis Academy.

Payments & Pro-Rating: All participants, including members and non-members, must make full payment at the time they sign up. No pro-rating will be given for missed classes. Pro-rated fees will only be given to players who are enrolling in a class after the start date, as long as there are openings in that class.

Make-Ups: The DTC does not offer make-up options for missed classes except in rare situations. Make-ups are not guaranteed. Make-ups will only be possible if your class meets on another day and is not full. All make-ups must be pre-approved by your instructor and occur during the same session. Make-ups are nearly impossible in the January – March session. There are no make-ups for missed days in the Academy.
